Jayne Russell Jackson age 73 of Kingston died December 4, 2020 at Roane Medical Center. Jayne graduated from MTSU in 1970. She returned home to Roane County to begin her teaching career as an enthusiastic educator for 35 years and attended Kingston United Methodist Church. Jayne along with her husband Doug co-founded the Roane County Anti-Drug coalition in 2002 after the tragic death of their son Joshua. Jayne enjoyed creating wheel thrown pottery, reading, writing, poetry, following sons' sporting activities, spending time with her grandchildren, visiting nursing homes with a focus on those who had no one and listening to a wide variety of music ranging from bluegrass, to rock, to classical.
