



## Alfred Thomas Kinser

June 19, 1925 - April 15, 2016

Alfred T. Kinser age 90, of Kingston, passed away Friday April 15, 2016. The Kinser family moved from Etowah to Kingston in 1933. Alfred's parents, John Malcolm (Doc) and Sue Thomas Kinser, established the drugstore that became a popular downtown gathering place for all ages. In addition to working at the drugstore, Alfred spent his childhood and teen years with activities at Bethel Presbyterian, with Boy Scout Troop 101 attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, and fishing at any opportunity. He graduated in the Roane County High class of 1943 and attended the University of Tennessee briefly before his military duties landed him in France and Belgium. He was an active member of American Legion Post 110.
