Anderson McCulley, age 82 Pastor Emeritus of First Baptist Church of Sweetwater, passed away on Monday December 27, 2004, at Sweetwater Hospital. Mr. McCulley has served as pastor of Beaver Dam Baptist Church, Knoxville, First Baptist Church, Sweetwater, and First Baptist, Niota and has filled in a number of other churches on an interim basis. He was a graduate of Carson-Newman College and Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY. His denominational contributions have been a member of the Executive Board of the Tennessee Baptist Convention, Trustee Baptist Children's Homes and Harrison 'Chilhowee Academy, Vice-Pres. of T.B.C. and Vice-Pres. of TN. Baptist Pastor's Conference. His ministry at Sweetwater has been longer than that of any other minister in its 144yr. history. Preceded in death by his daughter and son-in-law: Emily and Bill Clody.
