ANNIE MAE GOINS AGE 65 OF HARRIMAN WAS CALLED TO HER HEAVENLY HOME ON SATURDAY MARCH 6, 2004 AT THE ROANE MEDICAL CENTER. SHE WAS BORN ON SEPTEMBER 26, 1938, TO THE UNION OF ALBERT AND PEARL MOORE.
