BEULAH "KATHERINE" TEFFETELLER ELMORE AGE 63 OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF SEPTEMBER 16TH AT METHODIST MEDICAL CENTER IN OAK RIDGE. SHE IS SURVIVED BY HER HUSBAND OF FORTY THREE YEARS, WILLIAM "HAROLD", AND ALSO BY THEIR FOUR CHILDREN, JOYCE DENISE "JOY", MICHAEL DEWAYNE, CHARLES RAY AND CHERYL KAY, ALL OF KINGSTON. SHE WAS A MEMBER OF CEDAR GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH IN KINGSTON FOR 26 YEARS. SHE SERVED THERE AS CO-CHILDREN'S CHURCH DIRECTOR. FUNERAL 8PM FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 19, 2003 AT KYKER CHAPEL.
