



## Bobbie Jack Taylor

Bobbie Jack Taylor age 78 of Harriman passed away Saturday May 21, 2005 at Rockwood Heath Care Center. A member of Caney Ford Baptist Church, Bobbie Jack was preceded in death by parents: Robert Lee & Hope Taylor; brothers Frank & Homer Taylor; sister Faye Brooks, and grandson Stacey Taylor.
