



Bobby Dale Weaver

September 7, 1930 - March 5, 2017

Bobby Dale Weaver, age 86, of Paint Rock, TN., passed away on Sunday, March 5, 2017, at the family home. He was born in Paint Rock in 1930 to Rupert Tyson Weaver and Lela Grace (Easter) Weaver. He attended Paint Rock and Midway School before joining the Marines in 1948 at the age of 17. He served tours of duty in Europe and Asia including Korea and Vietnam. In 1954 he married Norma Rose Adamoli of Lee, MA., they had two children. She died of cancer in 1969. He also married Mary Scieszka in 1974 and she died in 1975. In 1970 he began the Berkshire Fence Company, and grew it into a vibrant and thriving business. It continues today as one of the major fence construction companies in the Bay State. In 1989 he retired from Berkshire Fence and returned to Paint Rock and married Ida Gaylon of Paint Rock. She passed away in 2011. Bobby Dale was preceded in death by his brothers John Carl and Billy Rupert Weaver and sisters: Patricia Ann Sirras and Dorothy Carolyn Weaver, step-sons: Raymond and Hal Gaylon. 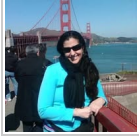
