Charles Richard Haile age 76 of Tellico Village formerly of Kingston, passed away Thursday August 25, 2011 at Fort Sanders Parkwest Medical Center. A graduate of Oak Ridge High School, where he lettered in football, baseball, basketball and track, known as Peanut Haile.
