Charles William Hamill, 88 grand years on this wonderful earth, passed away peacefully at 10:25 am on May 7, 2009 with family at his side. He was a loving father, husband, grandfather and human being. Mr. Hamill was Captain in the Marine Corp 1942-1945 World War II Pacific Islands. He Graduated from University of Chattanooga and attended Duke University. Awarded Best All Round Athlete – Templeton Trophy at University of Chattanooga in 1942/1943. He was a Teacher and Coach at South Pittsburg, TN High School in 1949 to 1951 and having undefeated and untied football seasons in 1949/1950 and 1950/1951. Bill served the Kingston community by coaching little league baseball, football and basketball, he was an avid golfer and athlete.
