Mr. Charles Thomas (C.T.) McLoughlin, 72, of Harriman, Tennessee, passed away on August 11, 2013. Born October 21, 1940 in Rockwood, Tennessee, he was the son of the late John (Mac) and Louise McLoughlin.

He attended Rockwood High School and graduated college from Tennessee Tech. He received his Masters degree from the University of Tennessee. He was employed with B&W Y-12 and spent 47 years working in Oak Ridge in the Engineering division.

He was a fanatical UT Vols fan and an avid golfer. He founded the PU-SU Golf tournament in 1973 and directed it for 39 years.

He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and friend to many. He was preceded in death by his wife Judy McLoughlin, sister Patti Jellicorse and brother Mike McLoughlin. He is survived by his son, Joe McLoughlin and wife Nichole, and daughter Meredith McKinney and husband Duane. He is also survived by two grandchildren George and Norah McLoughlin, and devoted nephew Tim Jellicorse.
