CHARLES L. SADLER JR. AGE 86 OF HARRIMAN PASSED AWAY FRIDAY JANUARY 18, 2002 AT HOME. HE WAS BORN FEBRUARY 15, 1915 IN ONEIDA, TN. HE MOVED TO HARRIMAN IN 1932 AND GRADUATED FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE IN 1936 AND THEN JOINED FIRST NATIONAL BANK IN HARRIMAN. HE WAS A LT. COMMANDER IN THE UNITED STATES NAVY DURING WORLD WAR II. HE THEN RETURNED TO THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK IN HARRIMAN IN 1945 WHERE HE WORKED UNTIL 1968. SERVING AS BANK PRISIDENT AND LATER AS CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD. HE WAS PAST PRESIDENT OF THE HARRIMAN ROTARY CLUB AND A MEMBER OF THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN HARRIMAN FOR 70 YEARS. SURVIVORS ARE WIFE, DOROTHY 'DOT' B. SADLER OF HARRIMAN, DAUGHTER AND SON IN LAW JUDY AND OLES MILLER OF BRISTOL, TN, SON AND DAUGHTER IN LAW JOHN C. AND MARGARET SADLER OF METAIRIE, LA, SON, BRAXTON L. SADLER OF KNOXVILLE, SON AND DAUGHTER IN LAW, CHARLES LEE JR AND SHEILA SADLER OF NASHVILLE, SISTER, RUTH SADLER STOWERS OF HOMEWOOD, AL, GRANDSON AND WIFE, CARLTON LEE AND MINDY MILLER OF TUCSON, AZ, GRANDDAUGHTER, JENNIFER CALDWELL OF WAUKEE, IA, AND LISA SADLER OF PAWLEYS ISLAND, SC.
