Charlie Randolph passed away Sunday April 21, 2024, at 4:30am at Methodist Medical Center in Oak Ridge, TN of Acute Myeloid Leukemia that was discovered a few days before. 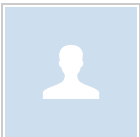
