August 18, 1924 - January 3, 2011

Dorothy (Dot) Rose Bledsoe of Sweetwater peacefully went to her heavenly home the 3rd day, January 2011, at Sweetwater Hospital. A devoted wife and mother, Dot was born and raised in Sweetwater, Tennessee. She married Carl E. Bledsoe of Philadelphia on October 23, 1943 and they had one daughter, Lydia Jane (Susie) Bledsoe. Dot retired from the McMinn County School System as a bookkeeper.
