



Dr. Eugene E. Ketchen

May 3, 1921 - December 30, 2011

Dr. Eugene Ketchen age 90 of Kingston passed away December 30, 2011 at NHC in Knoxville where he had been a resident for the past three years. Eugene E. Ketchen was born May 3, 1921 in Miami, FL the only child of August and Gertrude Ketchen. Following his graduation from the University of Miami, Eugene enlisted in the Army Air Corp and served in Dakar, Senegal, Africa during WWII as a weather forecaster and air controller. He achieved the rank of First Lieutenant. Following his military service Eugene enrolled in graduate school at the University of Pittsburgh where he earned a PhD in Chemistry. Dr. Ketchen taught briefly at Washington & Jefferson (PA) College. On June 10, 1951 Eugene married Ruth Whitton of Ironton, OH. In October of 1951 Dr. Ketchen was employed at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory where for more than 30 years he worked in the Isotopes Division. In his later years he was a certified industrial hygienist at ORNL. Dr. Ketchen and his family moved to Kingston in 1952. For many years he was an elder in the Morrison Hill Christian Church and in later years was a member of the Kingston Church of Christ. Dr. Ketchen served on the boards of the Christian Holy Land Foundation and the Smoky Mountain Christian Men's Fellowship. His areas of interest included photography, woodworking and traveling. Eugene was an avid University of Miami Football fan.

Dr. Ketchen is survived by three sons and their wives; John and Marsha of Knoxville, Jim and E. Anne of Francesville (IN) and Joe and Debbie of

Mascot. He was preceded in death by his wife Ruth on August 26, 1990. Eugene has four grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
