FRANKLIN P. (TOMMY) MUNSEY PASSED AWAY ON THURSDAY OCTOBER 23, 2003 THE DAY OF HIS 85TH BIRTHDAY. MR. MUNSEY LEAVES BEHIND CHILDREN, GRANDCHILDEN AND GREAT GRANDCHILDREN WHO LOVED HIM VERY MUCH AND WHOM HE LOVED SO DEARLY. HE LIVED HIS LIFE FOR THE LORD AND FOR HIS FAMILY. HE WAS A FAITHFUL MEMBER OF FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH WHERE HE ENJOYED TEACHING SUNDAY SCHOOL, THE DUCT TAPE CLASS, FOR MORE THAN 30 YEARS, AND FOR MANY YEARS WAS SEEN OUT FRONT AS A GREETER NO MATTER WHAT THE WEATHER. HE WAS A VETERAN OF WORLD WAR II SERVING THE US NAVY AND WAS RETIRED FROM UNION CARBIDE CORPORATION AFTER 36 YEARS OF COMPANY SERVICE.
