GERALD (JERRY) HUTTON AGE 59, LONG TIME RESIDENT OF OAK RIDGE DIED SATURDAY AFTERNOON, NOVEMBER 8, 2003 AT METHODIST MEDICAL CENTER IN OAK RIDGE, TENNESSEE.
