Glenn Haggard Shannon of Kingston passed away Monday June 8, 2009. A native of Wartburg, TN Morgan County, presently residing Kingston, TN, Roane County, where he has lived for the past fifty years. He was a member of First Baptist church where he had been active in many programs, serving as teacher of young men's Sunday School Class, discipleship training director. He served on a pastor search committee three different times and was an active deacon for eighteen years. He served as one of the money counters and was chairman of the benevolence committee. In 1990 he was recognized for his outstanding service to the church. He was member of Young- at Heart where he served three terms as president. He was a member of ESP Choir and was willing to serve anywhere he was needed. He taught biology and was a high school basketball coach for five years.
