January 18, 1932 - July 26, 2002

HARRY JERIMAH HAHN JR. 70 OF KINGSTON DIED FRIDAY JULY 26, 2002 AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE HOSPITAL IN KNOXVILLE. HE WAS BORN IN COVINGTON, VA ON JANUARY 18, 1932. HE MOVED TO OAK RIDGE IN 1945 AND GRADUATED FROM OAK RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL. HE RETIRED FROM THE ARMY AS MASTER SARGENT AFTER SERVING OVER 22 YEARS.
