Henry Kyle Agee, Jr. age 72 of Kingston passed away Tuesday January 6, 2015 at the Cumberland Medical Center. He was of the Baptist faith and attended First Baptist Church, Kingston. He worked at the Duncan Agee Dept. Store with his family for many years and was blessed to meet and befriend a lot of people there. He served on the Roane County Industrial Board, where he helped to promote job growth by attracting industry to the area.
