HOYET LEE BROWN SR. OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY SATURDAY NOVEMBER 29, 2003 AT METHODIST MEDICAL CENTER IN OAK RIDGE. HE WAS BORN AUGUST 5TH 1910 IN HARDIN CO. TENNESSEE TO WILLIAM AND VIOLET BROWN. HE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY ONE BROTHER AND TWO SISTERS AND A GRAND DAUGHTER ELIZABETH RAY. HE IS SURVIVED BY A SISTER EVELYN LEE OF MEMPHIS. A SON FROM ENID, OKLAHOMA; HOYET BROWN AND WIFE PAULA; GRANDSON JEROME BROWN AND WIFE KRISTY; GREAT GRANDDAUGHTERS HALEIGH, KALI AND ASHLYNNE OF OKLAHOMA. HIS DAUGHTER WANDA WILSON AND HUSBAND STEVE OF KINGSTON; GRANDSON TONY AND GREAT GRANDSON NICK. HIS DAUGHTER ANN BENSON OF OKLAHOMA CITY; GRANDSONS TERRY FLOYD, DANIEL FLOYD, DAVID BENSON AND JOHNNY BENSON. HOYET SERVED IN WWII FROM MARCH 14, 1942 UNTIL OCT. 30, 1945. HE SERVED IN NORMANDY, NORTHERN FRANCE, RHINELAND AND ARDENNES. HIS DECORATIONS INCLUDED PURPLE HEART, EAME THEATER RIBBON WITH FOUR BRONZE STARS, GOOD CONDUCT MEDAL AND SHARP SHOOTER RIFE BADGE. HOYET LIVED IN KINGSTON FOR OVER 50 YEARS. HIS FAMILY AND MANY FRIENDS WILL MISS HIM GREATLY. THE FAMILY WILL RECEIVE FRIENDS FROM 10AM UNTIL 12 NOON TUESDAY AT KYKER FUNERAL HOME IN KINGSTON. THE FUNERAL WILL FOLLOW AT 12 NOON WITH REV. RONNIE NICKELL OFFICIATING. BURIAL IN OAK
