Hulda Belle Stegall Todd made her transition at age 59 in Harriiman, Tenn. on October 25th, 2005. She was born in Kingston, Tennessee on Nov. 5th, 1945 to the parents of Roland Sr. and Lena Hudson-Stegall. Hulda moved to Detroit, Michigan with her family in 1947. She was a graduate of Wilbur Wright High School in 1962, where she majored in nursing. Later, she relocated to San Francisco, Calif. where she started her career as a nurse in 1969. She returned to Detroit, Mi. where she continued her nursing career and was later employed by the State of Michigan, Dept. of Mental Health and Dept. of Social Services for a total of 15 years before retirement. While living in Detroit, she was joined in holy matrimony to Lloyd (June) Todd, Jr., who preceded her in death in 1993. Retirement returned Hulda to her roots as she moved back to Tennessee in late 1993 and became a member of Williams Chapel Church in Emory Gap, Tenn.
