Jack Edward Muecke age 89 of Kingston passed away Wednesday March 23, 2016 at the Methodist Medical Center. A descendant of clan Rose of Scotland and the Muecke family originally of Austria and settled in Kingston in 1849. He owned Muecke Marina and Tire for over 50 years in Kingston and sold the first TV's; Air Conditioners and Radios in Kingston. An active member of Bethel Presbyterian Church and was active in the Hands of Mercy. Jack served in the U.S. Army in the 401st Engineering Combat Battalion during World War II and was active active in the Roane County Rescue Squad for many years. Preceded in death by his parents Joseph and Mary Kate Rose Muecke; sisters Mary O'Briant; Elizabeth Muecke; Nell Muecke; Charlotte Muecke and brothers Joseph Muecke; James Muecke and Charles Muecke.
