



## Jere Lovell Hogue Hall

September 18, 1932 - August 3, 2010

Jere Lovell Hogue Hall, of Kingston in Roane County, TN went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, August 3, 2010. She was a member of the Kingston United Methodist Church, Roane County Heritage Commission (RCHC) and the Daughters of the American Revolution. She was president of RCHC 1982-83 and again from 1985-90 and continued to serve as a member of the board of directors until her death. She was RCHC "Gala" chair in 2005. She had been a member of RCHC since the late '70's. She walked with Lamar Alexander to raise awareness of the courthouse restoration. She started the Roane County museum of History and Art. She and Jane Parker wrote a play entitled "An Accurate History of Kingston, TN 1799-1807" for the Capitol for a day celebration in 1982. She wrote numerous articles for the Heritage Commission news letters and the Roane County News and with Jack Shelley she edited the book "Valley of Challenge and Change, Roane County, Tennessee, 1860-1900. She was an accomplished writer, artist and loved landscaping and gardening. She graduated from Oklahoma State University with degrees in Music and English and moved to Kingston in 1961. Preceded in death by husband Joseph C. Hall, parents Marvin and Mary Hogue, brother Jimmy Hogue, father in law Carter Hall, step father in law Doyle Barnett. She will be greatly missed by all.
