KENNETH HUNT MOORE, JR., AGE 66, PASSED AWAY FEBRUARY 1, 2003 AT HIS HOME IN KINGSTON, AFTER A BRAVE FIGHT WITH CANCER. GRADUATED FROM LAFOLLETTE HIGH SCHOOL IN 1954. SERVED 3 YEARS IN U. S. ARMY SIGNAL CORP AS A RADIO OPERATOR. ATTENDED TENNESSEE TECH IN COOKEVILLE. WORKED 31 YEARS AS INSTRUMENT TECHNICIAN MARTIN MARIETTA AT K-25 AND X-10. WAS A AMATEUR EXTRA HAM RADIO OPERATOR AND PAST PRESIDENT OF EAST TENNESSEE HAM RADIO OPERATORS ASSOCIATION. SERVED 13 YEARS AS A VOLUNTEER HUNTER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR FOR TWRA. GREATEST LOVE AND PASSION WAS GROUSE HUNTING AFTER RETIREMENT. PRECEDED IN DEATH BY PARENTS KENNETH AND MARGARET AGEE MOORE OF LAFOLLETTE, AND YOUNGER BROTHER JAMES LAMAR MOORE OF PHOENIX, AZ.
