January 5, 1916 - April 19, 2000

LEONARD HATFIELD (JIM) GUETTNER AGE 84 OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY WEDNESDAY APRIL 19, 2000 AT ROANE MEDICAL CENTER. HE WAS A MEMBER OF UNION CHAPEL MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH WHERE HE SERVED AS A DEACON AND WAS A TRUSTEE AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH. HE WAS AN ARMY VETERAN OD WWII. HE SERVED IN THE 106 FIELD ARTILLERY BATTALION WHERE HE FOUGHT MANY BATTLES INCLUDING THE BATTLE AT OKINAWA WHICH IS REMEMBERED AS ONE OF THE GREATEST BATTLES OF THE PACIFIC. HE RETIRED FROM UNION CARBIDE Y-12 CORPORATION (NUCLEAR DIVISION) IN OAK RIDGE IN 1974 AFTER 28 YEARS OF SERVICE. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN LEGION. PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS FIRST WIFE EVELYN WARD GUETTNER, HIS BROTHERS ELMER, PERRY AND ED GUETTNER AND SISTERS BLANCHE FARMER AND GLADYS JOHNSTON.
