June 3, 1932 - October 21, 2024

Lloyd E. Langley, 92 of Sweetwater, TN passed away on October 21, 2024 at Sweetwater Hospital. Lloyd graduated from Sweetwater High School, Class of 1950. He was a life-long member of the First Methodist Church in Sweetwater. Lloyd was a member of the Tennessee National Guard's 278th Regimental Combat Team, which was federalized for service during the Korean War. He served in Korea from September 1951 to August 1952 as the platoon sergeant of the weapons platoon of "I" company, 31st Infantry. Lloyd married the love of his life, Mildred Bettis, before he left for Korea. They had one son, Michael Lloyd Langley of Maryville, TN and one grandson, Sean Michael Langley, of Maryville. Lloyd was the proprietor of Langley's Grocery on Morris Street in Sweetwater from 1963 to 1977. He then worked as a machinist at Carbology in Lenoir City until his retirement in 1997. He was preceded in death by his parents Thomas Hampton Langley and Mable Emmaline Browder Langley and brothers David, Thomas (Tony), and Kenneth.

Lloyd is survived by his loving wife of 73 years, Mildred, son Michael (Cindy), grandson Sean, brother Clyde W. Langley, sisters-in-law Wanda Skinner and Stella Wilkerson. He loved and was loved by multiple generations of nieces and nephews.
