Rev. Louis T. Hill, of Kingston, born June 17, 1924, has gone to be with our Lord and Savior on Monday November 28, 2011. Louis enlisted in the United States Marine Corp on December 13, 1941 at age 17, where he was assigned to the newly formed 3rd Marine Division, and participated in several Island assault landings. After his Discharge, he joined the Knoxville Police Dept. After 25 years of service, he retired in 1972 as Lt., Chief of Detectives, Juvenile Division. In 1969, he was ordained as a Methodist Minister, serving as part time Preacher, until his retirement from the Police Dept., at which time he became a full time Preacher. He finally retired for good in 2009, after 40 years of Preaching. Preceded in death by father Sydney Hill, mother Margret Bailey Moonyham, brother Jack Hill, sister Barbara Mays, and wife Ruth Hill.

Survived by sons and daughter in laws James and Peggy of Pickford, MI; Michael and Sandy of Kingston, 3 grandsons, and 6 great grandchildren, several nieces and nephews, and special friends.

Funeral 7pm Thursday December 1, 2011 in the Kyker Chapel with Rev. Brenda Poole officiating. Burial 11am Friday at Woodlawn Cemetery in Knoxville.
