Margaret Leona Snow Byrd, 95, of Kingston, TN, departed this life Tuesday, December 3 surrounded by her family at Jamestowne Assisted Living.

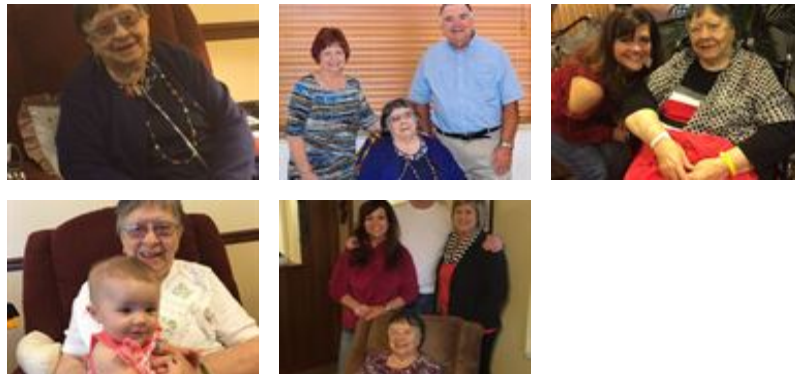
