Margaret Elizabeth Selewski age 66 of Rockwood, passed away Thursday, February 27, 2025. Beth earned her bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from Tennessee Tech University where she was a member of Zeta Tau Alpha national women's fraternity and Tau Beta Pi engineering honor society. After graduation, she worked as a systems engineer at Tennessee Valley Authority Watts Bar Nuclear Plant until retirement. Beth excelled in the sciences, but also loved gardening, theater, dance and travel. She danced and volunteered for many years at Arts in Motion, where she especially enjoyed helping young dancers as the nutcracker backstage "mouse wrangler" and as chaperone on trips to New York City.
