MARY ANN DUCKETT BURGER OF KINGSTON DIED FEBRUARY 27, 2001 AT THE BRIARCLIFF HEALTH CARE CENTER ON OAK RIDGE WHERE SHE HAD BEEN RESIDENT FOR THREE YEARS. SHE WAS BORN IN CLEVELAND, TN. ON JULY 14, 1920. HER PARENTS WERE DAVID AND MINNIE DUCKETT.
