MAXINE GORBY RINEHART AGE 84 OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY SUNDAY JULY 30, 2000 AT METHODIST MEDICAL CENTER IN OAK RIDGE. SHE WAS BORN IN THE OHIO VALLEY AT PINE GROVE, WEST VIRGINIA ON JANUARY 21, 1916 TO FRANK RICHMOND AND MARTHA McALLISTER GORBY. SHE WAS THE WIDOW OF ORAL RINEHART, WHO WAS THE FIRST FINANCIAL OFFICER FOR UNION CARBIDE NUCLEAR AND A FOUNDING TRUSTEE OF METHODIST MEDICAL CENTER. MRS. RINEHART WAS A MEMBER OF KINGSTON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH AND WAS ONCE AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE KINGSTON'S WOMEN'S CLUB, RIVERBEND GARDEN CLUB, LITERARY CLUB, REPUBLICAN WOMEN'S CLUB AND SHE WAS AN AVID BRIDGE PLAYER. SHE IS SURVIVED BY HER SON, DAVID RINEHART OF ATLANTA, GA.; DAUGHTER AND SON IN LAW, MARY ANN AND DENNY GESSEL; GRANDSONS BENJAMIN AND TIMOTHY GESSEL ALL OF KINGSTON, AND NEPHEW LOREN RINEHART, JR. OF BELINGTON, W.V. THE FAMILY WILL RECEIVE FRIENDS FROM 6 UNTIL 8PM THURSDAY AUGUST 3, 2000 AT KYKER FUNERAL HOME IN KINGSTON.
