



Nell Faith Pinkerton

June 28, 1913 - November 17, 2010

Nell F. Pinkerton, age 97 of Nashville, passed away on November 17, 2010 at the Harriman Care And Rehabilitation Center in Harriman, Tennessee where she had lived for the past few years.

She graduated from Middle Tennessee State Teachers College (now MTSU) in 1934, was a Home Economics Teacher at Howard High School and East High School in Nashville and later became Director of Home Economics in the Metro School System. She was Seventeen Magazine's National Home Economics Teacher of the Year in 1960, and co-authored the Nashville Cookbook (later purchased by Southern Living Magazine) for the Nashville Area Home Economics Association. She was a member of Inglewood Methodist Church where she taught Sunday School for several years, and was very active in the Woman's Club of Nashville. She was an inspiration to all who knew her. She was preceded in death by parents Grant and Maude Faith, sisters Floy Johnson and Ethlyn Faith, and husband James M. Pinkerton.
