NEVA JEANNETTE JOHNSON BROWN AGE 87 OF HARRIMAN PASSED AWAY SATURDAY JUNE 23, 2001 AT ROANE MEDICAL CENTER. SHE WAS A MEMBER OF TRENTON STREET BAPTIST CHURCH. PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER HUSBAND CHARLES ALBERT BROWN, PARENTS JAMES & SUSAN JOHNSON, & SEVERAL BROTHERS & SISTERS. MRS. BROWN GRADUATED FROM HARRIMAN HIGH SCHOOL & KNOXVILLE BUSINESS COLLEGE. MRS. NEVA BROWN WAS APPOINTED CITY CLERK FOR THE CITY OF HARRIMAN FOR AN EIGHT YEAR TERM, & THEN RAN FOR PUBLIC OFFICE & ELECTED CITY TREASURE FOR FOUR TERMS. SHE WAS THE FIRST WOMAN TO BE ELECTED TO A FULL TIME OFFICIAL OFFICE IN THE CITY'S HISTORY. IN 1964 NEVA BROWN'S HUSBAND OF 23 YEARS DIED UNEXPECTEDLY, THREE YEARS LATER MRS. BROWN RETIRED FROM HER CITY TREASURE'S POSITION & RESIDES AT HER HOME IN MIDTOWN HEIGHTS IN HARRIMAN, TN. WHERE SHE ENJOYED THE LOVE & SUPPORT OF HER SONS, GRANDCHILDREN, GREAT GRANDCHILDREN & OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS. SURVIVORS: SON CHARLES A.
