NEWTON BROWDER JONES of Little Silver, N.J., died September 26, 2003 at the Meridian Nursing Home, Red Bank, N.J., after a brief illness. Born Feb. 24, 1919 in Sweetwater, he had been in declining health for the past year. He was the son of the late Oliver King Jones and Byrd Browder Jones. An honor graduate of Tennessee Military Institute, Sweetwater, he served as Cadet Colonel. He graduated from Southwestern College in Memphis and from Lowell Textile Institute in Lowell, Mass. For two and a half years he served during World War II, in the U.S. Army, stationed in the Aleutian Islands in Alaska. He retired as a captain. Jones served for many years as a sales agent for Sweetwater Hosiery Mills, associated with his brothers, the late King Jones and Jackson Jones and for Crescent Hosiery Mills in Niota.
