May 22, 1918 - April 20, 2010

Pauline D. "Pudgy" Nolan, 91, of Harriman, TN went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 at Harriman Care & Rehab Center in Harriman following a lengthy illness. Mrs. Nolan was born in Flint, Michigan on May 22, 1918 and was the daughter of Russell Perham Beckley and Alice Emmaline Owens. Mrs. Nolan was a long-time musician and a gifted artist and seamstress. She relocated from Michigan to Tennessee in 1988 and has been a member of Trenton Street Baptist Church in Harriman.

She is survived by one son and daughter-in-law, Richard and Donna Hall of Harriman, five grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
