Obituary of Robert Kenneth Morris

New York, New York – Robert (“Bob”) K. Morris of Watermill New York, passed away Wednesday July 20, 2022, peacefully surrounded by his loving family. He was 87 years old. Bob was raised in the Bronx, New York and later attended Georgia Tech and New York University receiving a Bachelors of Science degree and thereafter a Masters in Mechanical Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnical Institute. Bob worked as an engineer designing nuclear power plants throughout the world. After leaving engineering, Bob became a successful real estate investor and developer in New York, South Carolina and Florida.

Bob lived in Connecticut, New York and New Jersey although Bob was most at home in the Hamptons, New York where he enjoyed sharing his beautiful homes with friends and family. In later years he called Williams Island, Florida his home during the winter. As an avid collector of fine art, Bob filled his homes with many of the pieces he acquired throughout his lifetime.

Bob was pre-deceased by his son Steven Morris and his wife, Jewel Morris and his three sisters Evelyn, Pauline and Roslyn. Bob leaves behind his beloved Pomeranian, Annie.
