GENEVIEVE ROBISON CHAMBLISS AGE 91 OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY FRIDAY JANUARY 3, 2003 AT ROCKWOOD HEALTH CARE CENTER OF COMPLICATIONS FROM A STROKE SUFFERED IN NOVEMBER. SHE HAD RESIDED AT JAMESTOWNE ASSISTED LIVING AND FARMINGTON TRAIL IN KINGSTON BEFORE HER ILLNESS. GENEVIEVE WAS BORN MAY 5, 1911 IN SEDALIA , MISSOURI TO DANIEL BARTON ROBISON AND EDNA BARR ROBISON. SHE WAS THE WIDOW OF FEDERAL MAGISTRATE SIZER CHAMBLISS OF CHATTANOOGA AND LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN, TENNESSEE. FOR OVER 25 YEARS GENEIVEVE SERVED AS THE CLERK OF THE FEDERAL BANKRUPTCY COURT IN CHATTANOOGA. SHE WAS A FAITHFUL MEMBER OF THE WEST HILLS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF HARRIMAN. SERVING IN SEVERAL CAPACITIES ON MISSIONS BOARDS. SPREADING THE WORD OF JESUS CHRIST IN FOREIGN LANDS WAS AN ON GOING PROJECT IN ALL HER ADULT LIFE. AN ACCOMPLISHED PAINTER AND PORTRAITIST, HER WORK WAS FEATURED IN SEVERAL ART SHOWS AND IS HUNG IN HOMES ACROSS THE COUNTRY. SHE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER PARENTS, HER HUSBAND AND HER SISTERS AND BROTHERS IN LAW, GRACE R. SCOFIELD (ROBERT) AND ANNABELLE R. STORTO (ED). GENEVIEVE IS SURVIVED BY CARING STEPSONS, TOM CHAMBLISS OF OREGON, DAN CHAMBLISS OF NEW YORK, AND ALEXANDER CHAMBLISS OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE. ALSO
