Steven Lynn Schrock, 67, of Kingston, Tennessee, previously from New Paris, Indiana, passed away Friday, November 11th, 2005 in Oak Ridge, Tn. Steve was born on Dec. 7, 1937, in Foraker, Indiana to LaMar and Lucille Schrock, who preceded him in death. On July 3rd, 1955 he married Carol Iffert who survives. Steve was a beloved husband, father, grandfather and brother. He was a man of integrity and always displayed grace under pressure.
