THOMAS WINDELL SELBY – age 74, of Kingston passed away peacefully on the morning of Tuesday, June 22, 2010 at the Methodist Medical Center in Oak Ridge, TN. Tom was born August 20, 1935 in Pikeville, TN to the late Henry and Lola Selby. He was a member of Cedar Grove Baptist Church, where he served as deacon, adult Sunday school teacher and was a vital influence in all areas of the church. He graduated from Bledsoe County High School in 1954 as Valedictorian of his class. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry from Tennessee Tech University, Cookeville, TN and his Masters Degree in Science from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. He was employed at Union Carbide, later Martin Marietta, K-25 plant for over 40 years from which he retired in 1998. He was the recipient of several U. S. patents, and published numerous papers during his career.
