



Virginia Helen Davis "Ginny" Warlick

March 2, 1923 - May 17, 2013

Virginia Helen Davis "Ginny" Warlick of Kingston died on May 17, 2013 at NHC Healthcare of Oak Ridge, Tennessee. She was born March 2, 1923 in Clarksburg, West Virginia to Virginia Helen Nedrow and Ross McKenzie Davis.

She attended public schools in Ohio, Pennsylvania and West Virginia. She studied at West Virginia University and received the Registered Nurse degree from the School of Nursing of Duke University in 1945. On marrying George C. Warlick, Jr. in 1945, she came to Oak Ridge, where she had her three children before moving to Kingston in 1952. Until 1968, she was a homemaker, neighborhood nurse, and homeroom mother at the Kingston public schools.

In 1968 she resumed her professional career in nursing at Harriman Hospital in various administrative assignments until her retirement in 1985. She served on the boards of directors of the Oak Ridge Mental Health and the Family Medical Associates of Kingston. She was a member and elder of Bethel Presbyterian Church.

She was preceded in death, in addition to her parents, by a sister, Betty Shirk and brother, Robert Davis. Survivors include her husband, George, of 67 years, and children George C. Warlick, III (Cynthia) of Knoxville; Daniel D.

Warlick (Gail) of Nashville; and Jennifer L. Warlick (David M. Betson) of South Bend, Indiana. Seven grandchildren: Melissa L. Warlick of Knoxville; Erik D. Warlick of Boca Raton, FL; Katie G. Dorfler and Samuel A. Warlick of Nashville; Nicholas W. Betson of New Haven, CT; Elizabeth W. Betson and Andrew W. Betson of South Bend, IN. One great grandson is Carson Warlick of Boca Raton, FL.
