



## Vivian Louella Whited Grissinger

December 17, 1934 - June 11, 2017

Vivian Louella Whited Grissinger, 82, of Springfield, VA passed away June 11, 2017, at a Fairfax County hospital. She left behind her husband of 55 years, Charles R. Grissinger to cherish her memories and remember her laughter.

Vivian was born in Union County, TN but just prior to the construction of Norris Dam, her family relocated to Sweetwater when she was very young. After graduating from Hiwassee College, she began working in Washington, D.C. for the Department of Agriculture. Later she transferred to the Federal Aviation Administration, a division of the Department of Transportation from which she retired.

She was preceded in death by parents, J.H. and Thelma Whited, siblings— Calvin Verture, Helen Robbins, William Vernis, and James Varnell. Besides her husband Charles, Vivian is survived by one brother and one sister Ralph (Gail) Whited and Vera Hyatt; two aunts, Neil Elsea and Annie Whited; many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Vivian was a member of the National Baptist Memorial Church in Washington, D.C.
