W. GEORGE ERWIN AGE 62 OF KINGSTON PASSED AWAY THURSDAY NOVEMBER 20, 2003 AT FORT SANDERS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER. HE WAS A MEMBER OF LUMINARY UNITED METHODIST CHURCH. HE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS WILLIAM L. AND ELOISE ERWIN. SURVIVORS INCLUDE HIS WIFE JULIE; HIS CHILDREN BILL, SCOTT, AND TRACY; HIS GRANDCHILDREN GEORGE, DREW, 'BUBBA', AND MADELINE; HIS BROTHER SHERWOOD MAX; AND HIS MOTHER-IN-LAW MARY LUMPKIN.

HE WAS BORN MARCH 12, 1941 IN ALEXANDER CITY, ALABAMA; BUT GREW UP IN OAK RIDGE. HE WAS A GRADUATE OF OAK RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1959 AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE CLASS OF 1964. HE SERVED AS AN ARMY INFANTRY OFFICER FROM 1964 TO 1966. HE RETIRED TO TENNESSEE IN 1998 AFTER 32 YEARS IN THE PLASTIC BOTTLING INDUSTRY.
