



William (Bill) Albert Hewgley

April 3, 1931 - March 11, 2014

William Albert Hewgley (Bill), age 82, died at his home in Kingston, Tennessee on March 11, 2014. Bill is survived by his beloved wife of 56 years, Cynthia Presson Hewgley and his dedicated son William Allen Hewgley. Another special son Robert Andrew Hewgley who passed away on September 21, 2011, all of Kingston. Preceding Bill in death were his parents Robert Ashley Hewgley and Florence Carns Hewgley, both previously of Nashville, Tennessee; and a brother Robert Ashley Hewgley, Jr of Tullahoma, Tennessee. Bill is also survived by the following sister and brothers with their loving spouse's; Lucille Koback of Wesley Chapel, Florida; John L. Hewgley of Goodlettsville, Tennessee; and Lawrence C. Hewgley (Peggy) of Hendersonville, Tennessee.

In 1953, Bill graduated cum laude from the Vanderbilt University School of Engineering with a B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering. His subsequent career spanned a period of 40 years, with professional positions held at Union Carbide Corporation, Oak Ridge, Tennessee; Aerojet General Corporation, Azusa, California; Southwest Research Institute, San Antonio, Texas; and Lockheed Martin Energy Systems, Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Major Career achievements by Bill included developing advanced electrical insulation systems for use in outer space rotating electrical equipment and developing and implementing a family of reliability and quality assurance programs uniquely designed for use by a major research institute in military and space applications. Bill was the author of a number of technical papers and he

served in the U.S. Army Signal Corps from 1954 to 1956. Bill was a family man, a patriot, and a man with exemplary character.
